

DAILY SCHEDULE

Our day begins upon arrival of the first child and ends upon departure of the last child each day.

Children will be encouraged but will never be forced to participate in any activity.

- 7:00 a.m. Breakfast – Those children who arrive prior to 7:30 a.m. will be served breakfast.
- 8:00 a.m. Circle Time - Children will be given an opportunity to share any news or special experiences. During this time, we will sing interactive songs, such as “The ABC’s”, Patty Cake, Number Song and “Five Little Monkeys”.

- 8:45 a.m. Clean up. Toys are put away, bathroom time, and hands are washed before snack.
- 9:00 a.m. Morning Snack
- 9:30 a.m. Outside Play. If weather permit, we may go outside.
- 10:30 a.m. Hands are washed after outside play.
- 11:00 a.m. Free play. Children will choose their own games and activities. There will be a variety of toys, games, and activities available to the children geared toward enhancing their growth and development.
- 11:30 p.m. Hands are washed after playing. Lunch time.
- 12:30 p.m. Clean up and bathroom time. Children get ready for rest time.
- 1:00pm Nap / Quiet Play – Those children who have not fallen asleep by this time may play quietly. There are books, puzzles, educational computer games and a variety of toys available for quiet play.
- 3:00 p.m. Afternoon Snack
- 3:30 p.m. Group Activity Time –children will participate in our afternoon activity. This may involve arts & crafts, science & discovery, games, puzzles, etc. Some days this will be a planned activity based on our current theme or skill focus. Other days the children will be given materials to work on their own creations. As we finish our activity the children will move on to free play.

- 3:30 p.m. Free play. Children will choose their own games and activities. There will be a variety of toys, games, and activities available to the children

geared toward enhancing their growth and development. If weather permit, we may go outside.

- 4:15 p.m. Hands and faces are freshened up for mom and dad to pick up. Children are offered movie time and a variety of toys to play with while we wait for parents to pick up. Toys are to be put back before the child leaves for the day.
- 4:30 p.m. Parents pick up time.
