CHURCH HISTORY FACT

Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church congregation met in several **temporary locations from 1933 to 1945**. On October 24, 1945 land was acquired to build a permanent location in **"The Grove"** at 530 Gardner Street. The basement of the Church was completed and was used for Worship Services. Unfortunately, Rev. Boone passed away before the Sanctuary was completed. The second Pastor, Rev. L.F. Lacy and congregation completed the Sanctuary on September 27, 1959. Gardner Street does not exist any longer. The present day location would be near Dr. Joseph Lowery Boulevard and Lowe Avenue SW. The area is still known as **"The Grove"**.
