Voter Information–2020 Presidential Election! – The Madison County Absentee Ballot Office

is **now open!** You may go to the Madison County Courthouse 1st Floor near the License Department to cast your vote for the Presidential Election. The office is **open 8:30 am to 4:30 p.m.** **The last day to absentee vote at this office will be the Thursday, October 29th.** If you had an Absentee Ballot mailed to you it may be returned in person or mailed. Three (3) first class stamps are needed for postage to mail the ballot back to the Madison County Courthouse.

We are offering COVID-19 (coronavirus) drive-thru testing at our Meridianville center from **9am - 6pm Monday through Friday and 9am - 5pm on weekends.**

We test both patients who have COVID-19 symptoms and those without symptoms who are worried that may have been exposed. No referrals are needed. Results typically take 3-5 days.

Please note this location is not open for Urgent Care services at this time.

COVID-19 evaluation and testing is 100% covered by most insurance plans.

We apologize, but we will not be testing a patient under 2 years old.
