High Blood Pressure

By living a healthy lifestyle, you can help keep your blood pressure in a healthy range. Preventing [high blood pressure](#), which is also called hypertension, can lower your risk for [heart disease](#) and [stroke](#).

Stroke

- Stroke is the **No. 2 cause of death worldwide** and a leading cause of disability. The American Stroke Association is a relentless force for a healthier world with fewer strokes and a division of the American Heart Association.
- Stroke, the **fifth leading cause of death in the United States**, can happen to anyone at any time.
- Stroke is the **No. 4 cause of death in women** and kills more women than men. In fact, one in five women has a stroke.
- African Americans are 50% more likely to have a stroke (cerebrovascular disease), as compared to their white adult counterparts
- Black men are 70% more likely to die from a stroke as compared to non-Hispanic whites
- African American women are twice as likely to have a stroke as compared to non-Hispanic white women

Stroke Symptoms: **By learning and sharing the F.A.S.T. warning signs, you just might save a life from stroke.**

Arthritis

- Arthritis is one of the most widespread health conditions in the United States. It affects about one in four adults overall.
- Arthritis affects working-age adults, older adults, and even children.
