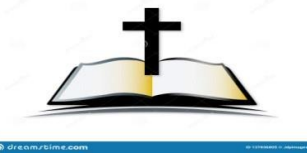

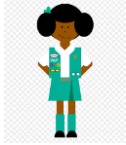

HEALTH AWARENESS FOR AUGUST - National Immunization Awareness Month

Vaccine-preventable diseases cause long-term illness, hospitalization, and even death.

In the United States:

CDC estimates that since 2010, flu-related hospitalizations in the United States have ranged from 140,000 to 710,000 and flu related deaths have ranged from 12,000 to 56,000.

- About 320,000 people get pneumococcal pneumonia every year, leading to over 150,000 hospitalizations and 5,000 deaths, mostly among the elderly.
- About 880,000 people have chronic hepatitis B, which can cause serious health problems, including liver damage, cirrhosis, liver cancer, and even death.
- HPV causes over 27,000 cancers in women and men each year. About 4,000 women die each year from cervical cancer.

Did You Know

Each year in the United States, 1 million people get shingles and some will have severe pain that can continue even long after their rash clears up (called post-herpetic neuralgia) or they may suffer from other painful complications that could persist for years.

VOTER INFORMATION



Upcoming Huntsville Municipal Election for Districts 2, 3 and 4. If you live in the city of **Huntsville in Districts 2, 3, and 4 mark your calendar for August 23, 2022**. This Election is for City Council and Huntsville City School Board in these districts. Remember anyone that is eighteen years old is eligible to register to vote. Registration may be done on the following websites: <http://www.madisoncountyvotes.com> or www.alabamavotes.gov. Voter registration status may also be verified at these sites.

Also, mark your calendar for the United States General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. **A total of 469 seats in the United States Congress are up for election**. Thirty-four (34) Senate seats and four hundred thirty-five (435) House of Representative seats. Remember, your vote is your voice. Exercise it wisely!
