HEALTH AWARENESS FOR JULY - VISION HEALTH

Keep Your Eyes Healthy - There's a lot you can do to keep your eyes healthy and protect your vision.

Protect your eyes

Every day, you can take simple steps to keep your eyes healthy. Use these tips to protect your eyes from things that can harm them:

Wear sunglasses. Protect your eyes from the sun by wearing sunglasses — even on cloudy days! Be sure to look for sunglasses that block 99 to 100 percent of both UVA and UVB radiation.

Wear protective eyewear. Safety glasses and goggles are designed to protect

your eyes during certain activities, like playing sports, doing construction work, or doing home repairs. You can buy them from most eye care providers and some sporting goods stores. Get tips to protect your kids' eyes when they play sports.

Give your eyes a rest. Looking at a computer for a long time can tire out your eyes. Rest your eyes by taking a break every 20 minutes to look at something about 20 feet away for 20 seconds.

If you wear contacts, take steps to prevent eye infections. Always wash your hands before you put your contact lenses in or take them out. Be sure to disinfect your contact lenses and replace them regularly. Learn more about caring for contact lenses.

VOTER INFORMATION

Upcoming Huntsville Municipal Election for Districts 2, 3 and 4. If you live in the city of **Huntsville in Districts 2, 3, and 4 mark your calendar for August 23, 2022.** This Election is for City Council and Huntsville City School Board in these districts. Remember anyone that is eighteen years old is eligible to register to vote. Registration may be done on the following websites: <http://www.madisoncountyvotes.com> or www.alabamavotes.gov.

Voter registration status may also be verified at these sites.
