Church History Fact – On **October 4, 1933**, Rev. O.D. Boone organized Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church at his home located on Blue Springs Road. On October 9, 1957 Rev. Boone was called from labor to reward after serving twenty-four years as Pastor. Two known Founder’s Day Celebrations in remembrances of Rev. O. D. Boone were held on October 2, 1985 and October 8, 1988.
