2. **October 24** – Registration deadline for the General Election
3. **November 1** – last day absentee ballot applications can be returned by mail
4. **November 3** – Last day absentee ballot applications can be returned by hand
5. **November 7** – Last day to return absentee ballots by hand to Absentee Election Manager
6. **November 8** – Absentee ballots must be returned by mail to the absentee election manager no later than noon
