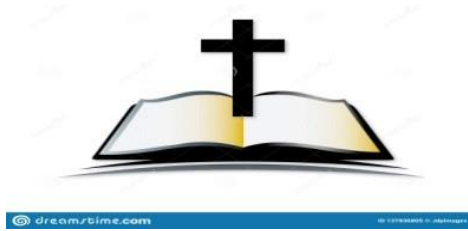

EMPLOYMENT

CHURCH HISTORY FACT FOR JANUARY 2023



Are you aware of the historical facts on the plaques at the entrance of all buildings of Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church? In earlier times, this information was written on the "corner stone" of an edifice. This corner stone was the first stone laid and was the foundation for all other stones. A plaque at the entrance of Orange Drive and duplicated at Winchester Road reads: **Union Chapel M.B. Church; Founded Oct. 4, 1933 by the Rev. O.D. Boone**; The Auditorium erected by Rev. L. F. Lacy; Sept. 27, 1959. **Deacon Board:** Tom Strong; Jake Pope; Ezell Swan; Robert Martin; W.E. Fletcher; Earnest Peckins; Willie Williams; E. D. Johnson. Carrie Moore, Clerk. There are many descendants of these early church leaders that are members of Union Chapel Church today. We Praise God for the service and leadership of these founders. "Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone."- Ephesians 2:19-21.
