1. **Full-time Custodian:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church has an immediate opening for a Full-time Custodian. This position will be responsible for performing

custodial maintenance duties, including dusting, mopping, finishing and buffing floors, vacuuming and shampooing carpets, cleaning and restocking restrooms.

2. **CDC Full-time Daycare Worker:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church Child Development Center (UCCDC) has immediate openings for Full-time Daycare Workers for the 2023 – 2024 school year. These positions create age-appropriate lesson plans and organizes curriculum activities; keeps records of each child's progress, interest, and any problems that may occur; attends to children's basic needs with feeding, dressing, changing diapers, etc. Performs other duties as required.

Must possess advanced multitasking, problem-solving, time-management, and interpersonal skills. 3. **CDC Full-time Assistant Director:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church Child Development Center (UCCDC) has an immediate opening for a **Full-time Assistant Director**. This position assists the Director in the management of the UCCDC; coordinates the requisition of supplies, equipment, and books; conducts inventories and maintains records of such materials; assists Child Care Providers in planning special programs, and field trips; answers telephone, cordially greets parents, and visitors; and coordinates safety inspections/drills and building permits.
