Church History Facts: JULY

67th Church Anniversary - Union Chapel M.B. Church 100 Orange Drive, where Dr. O. Wendell Davis is Pastor, observed its 67th Church Anniversary on Sunday August 20, 2000 at 7:45 AM and 10:45 AM worship services. The theme for the observance was "A Chosen Generation – Moving Forward on a Progressive Journey." (1 Peter 2:1-9) The Deacons of Union Chapel along with the Deacons of Owens Chapel led the Devotion. Responsive Reading from the theme was led by Pastor G. Calvin Boone. Pastor Cornell Martin led the congregation in prayer during Altar Call. The Owens Chapel Church Choir provided the Worship in songs and praise. The Sermon was delivered by Rev. Robert J. Brown, Pastor of Owens Chapel M.B. Church.... The worship and devotional services at the 10:45 worship services were led by the Deacons of Union Chapel, and the Union Chapel Anniversary Choir provided the worship in songs and praise. Minister Archie Morris, II, led the Responsive Readings, and Minister Horace Allen, Jr. led the congregation to the throne of Grace during the Altar Call. 1. **Full-time Custodian:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church has an immediate opening for a Full-time Custodian. This position will be responsible for performing custodial maintenance duties, including dusting, mopping, finishing and buffing floors, vacuuming and shampooing carpets, cleaning and restocking restrooms.
2. **CDC Full-time Daycare Worker:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church Child Development Center (UCCDC) has immediate openings for Full-time Daycare Workers for the 2023 – 2024 school year. These positions create age-appropriate lesson plans and organizes curriculum activities; keeps records of each child's progress, interest, and any problems that may occur; attends to children's basic needs with feeding, dressing, changing diapers, etc. Performs other duties as required.

Candidate Requirements: Must be a mature Christian professional who demonstrates a love for God and people. Must possess advanced multitasking, problem-solving, time-management, and interpersonal skills. Selected employees must be fully vaccinated for COVID and comply with any additional boosters or additional vaccination mandates issued by appropriate Federal, State, or local health authorities as a condition to employment.

3. **CDC Full-time Assistant Director:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church Child Development Center (UCCDC) has an immediate opening for a **Full-time Assistant Director**. This position assists the Director in the management of the UCCDC; coordinates the requisition of supplies, equipment, and books; conducts inventories and maintains records of such materials; assists Child Care Providers in planning special programs, and field trips; answers telephone, cordially greets parents, and visitors; and coordinates safety inspections/drills and building permits. Performs other duties as required.

Candidate Requirements: Must be a mature Christian professional who demonstrates a love for God and people. Must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university, preferably the degree should be in child development or a related field and a minimum of one year of experience in a child development center OR an associate degree in child development or early childhood education from a post-secondary CDC (technical, vocational, junior College), and at least two (2) years of working experience as a child-care worker/teacher or as a director/program director in a licensed daycare center or a Department approved setting.

4. **UCCA Full-time Teacher:** Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church Christian Academy (UCCA) has immediate openings for Full-time Academy Teachers for the 2023 – 2024 school year. These positions create lesson plans; grades homework; administers tests; and teaches basic skills in various subjects. Performs other duties as required.

Candidate Requirements: Must be a mature Christian professional who demonstrates a love for God and people. Must possess a Bachelor's degree from a college or university that held regional accreditation at the time; complete a teacher education program; and pass state exams for prospective educators.
