Staff Musician I

Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church (UCMBC) has an immediate opening for a Staff Musician I. The standard work week is flexible as agreed to by the Minister of Music and Director of Music. The Staff Musician assists in creating an atmosphere of celebration and reverence to God through music for all worship services in alignment with the mission and vision of the church. The position reports to and is supervised by the Minister of Music and Director of Music. Specific duties are outlined below or can be accessed at www.unionchapel-hsv.org.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS: The candidate must demonstrate Christian maturity in attitude, actions, and speech, showing a consistent walk with Jesus Christ; remembering that all work is sensitive to the spiritual needs of people. Serve as the primary musician accompaniment at regularly scheduled worship services, church programs, revivals, funerals, and special services as assigned by the Minister of Music/Director of Music. Serve as the primary musician accompaniment for weekly choir and musician rehearsals. Assist in musical presentations at any service as assigned by the Minister of Music/Director of Music. Model professional deportment and always be attentive to what is occurring during worship services. Attend, in its entirety (unless approved by the Minister of Music/Director of Music), Sunday worship services, rehearsals and other programs as assigned. Rehearse sufficiently to maintain a high quality of music as determined and scheduled by the Minister of Music/Director of Music.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Thorough working knowledge of worship and a theological understanding of church music. Proven ability to play piano, keyboard, and/or organ. Ability to play a variety of church music (traditional, contemporary, praise and worship, etc.). Ability to sight-read, play by ear, modulate, play with rhythmic integrity, and embellish music scores. Ability to arrange, adapt, and transcribe (as needed) repertoire for the choral groups and musicians. Experience as a team player with good interpersonal skills in an organization or business setting working cooperatively with church staff, musicians, music ministry members, and volunteers. Must have a degree of flexibility to meet the demands of a growing and involved music ministry.

COMPENSATION: Negotiable based on education and experience.
