Pastors United for Change, a group of church clergy from around North Alabama, met on the steps of the Madison County Courthouse on October 1, 2020, to sign a document declaring their beliefs and action plan for supporting racial unity. The call to action listed includes partnerships between predominately black and predominately white churches, support for the removal of the confederate monument at the Madison County Courthouse and support for further training in law enforcement agencies. The group's gathering was a response to what Pastors United for Change feels is a lack of support for racial unity from church leaders nationwide.
