- The final two books in the Chronicles of the King series by Lyn Austin: Bk. 4 *Faith of my Fathers*, centered on King Hezekiah; Bk. T *Among the Gods*, the story of King Manasseh's reign.
- *The Real Enemy*, book one of Kathy Herman's new series, the *Sophie Trace Trilogy*, about a Tennessee town's first female police chief.
- *The Sweet Gum Knit Lit Society* by Beth Patillo, the first book in this series about a group of ladies who meet once a month at church to knit and discuss books.
- *Unforgotten*, the sequel to *Secrets* by Kristen Heitzmann, sees Lance caught between the two women he loves as he uncovers unforgotten truths that could change them forever.
- *Hometown Favorite* by Bill Barton and Henry O. Armstrong concerns a football player who can turn around a losing football program, but he can't rebuild a devastated life.
- **The Centurions Wife** by Davis Bunn and Janette Oke in the very best personal story of Leah, compelled into a betrothal she never wanted, drawn by a faith she never expected.
- *The Edge of Recall* by Kristen Heitzmann is a romantic suspense novel about a young landscape architect who is trapped and ambushed in one of her own labyrinths.
