Mark 16:6	Since Jesus is risen from the dead, I will love and follow him.
1 Corinthians 15:22-23	God gave his best- the first fruits – I will be generous and give God the first fruits of the wealth he provides for me.

Statements from the Lesson

"We are no more in control of time and circumstances than the religious leaders and Pilate were in their determination not to have Jesus crucified on Passover week. "

"The abundant life Jesus promises is more than material prosperity- it is the life that pleases God, serves others, and is joyful and peaceful for you."

"The life promised by Jesus is not gained by trying harder but trusting in him more."

"Are you teaching your kids by words and actions to build wisely on Jesus?"

"Sometimes your kids may not listen to you but they never miss what you do."

"God will not fail you."

"You erase your negative self-images when you love God first."

"God should be your first priority and not your last resort."

"Bring passion to your priorities."

"Learn to respond to your priorities and not react to your circumstances."

"Setting priorities changes your direction not the passage of time."

"Putting God first makes everything else fall into its proper place."

"Obey what you know even when you don't understand it. The more you learn- the more you obey."

"A healthy marriage is rewarding because two people believe the commandments of marriage make for a great relationship."

"Marriages are always better when you realize your partner has your best interest at heart."

"Christianity for many is misery because they only view it as a religion and therefore, the commandments of God are a burden not a playbook for life."

"You can love someone and not trust them. You can trust someone and not love them. But when you love and trust someone- that's a great relationship."
